

### Colorful New Wind Chimes Feature Favorite Tractors, Livestock

No matter what brand of tractor you drive or what kind of livestock you raise, you'll like these colorful new wind chimes that show off your favorite tractor brand, old or new, or livestock.

The 31-in. long units consist of powder-coated metal tubes with laser-cut plexiglass tractors or animals suspended by a chain below them. The tubes range from 11 to 16 in. long.

Tractor brands include the Allis Chalmers

WD 45, Oliver 77, Deere models 7800, 8400, 720, A, and B; Farmall M, Ford 9N, Case-IH, Massey Ferguson, and Ford New Holland. The units are made with a laser-type printer on plexiglass and therefore cannot be customized.

### Wooden Bench Converts To Picnic Table

"You can convert a pair of my wood benches into a nice looking picnic table," says inventor Irvin Dierking.

The 6-ft. long benches have backrests. Flipping the backrest forward 90 degrees results in half a picnic table. Put the two benches together and you have a complete table with a 24-in. wide top.



The benches are sold "knocked down" ready to be screwed together. A single bench sells for \$75 (untreated wood) or \$85 (treated wood).

### Songbird Clock Sings Different Song Every Hour

You'll hear a different song every hour of the day with this new "songbird" clock that features 12 favorite bird songs.

The 13-in. dia. clock is trimmed in hunter green and has bird portraits in full color. They include a cardinal, mourning dove, robin, wren, mockingbird, finch, oriole, nuthatch, sparrow, titmouse, blue jay and a chickadee. Songs, which play for 12 seconds every hour on the hour, are provided by Cornell University's Ornithology Department.

A light sensor turns off the songs at night and back on again at dawn.

### Micro Luggage Security System

If you've ever sat in an airport or train station with one hand on your luggage to make sure no thief carries it off, you'll like this new two-piece anti-theft alarm.

"TrackIT" consists of a small transmitter and a receiver. You put the receiver inside your luggage, briefcase, laptop computer, or whatever else you might be carrying. The transmitter remains in your pocket.

The two pieces of the alarm communicate by radio signal. If they're ever separated by more than about 15 ft., a piercing siren on the receiver unit goes off. Most thieves will simply drop the stolen item at that point and take off.

### Separator Skims Fat From Soups

This new fat separator skims as much as 1 cup of fat from hot soups and stocks.

It consists of a two-handled dish with slotted sides. You simply dip the dish into the pot by the handles. Fat and floating scum flow in through the slots.
