High-Powered Cordless Vacuum

Vacuum manufacturers have been trying to eliminate power cords for a long time, but the lack of quality batteries has resulted in low suction power and poor results. But now Westinghouse has introduced a cordless vacuum that promises to set new standards in wireless power.

The key to the "Unplugged" vacuum is a quick-switch battery system. Two batteries are included along with a charging station. Each battery pack lasts 30 min. and the charging system can fully charge the batteries in 30 min. as well. This means that while one battery is powering the

vacuum, the other can charge to its full capacity. After the first battery runs out, the other one takes its place in a matter of seconds.

In addition to the convenience of a cordless design, the Unplugged has all the features of a traditional high-end vacuum such as a 4-stage HEPA air filter, extendable wand attachment, and a clear, bagless container system.

The Unplugged also has two separate motors, one for the suction and another for the rotating brush. This means that there are no belts to replace. The two motors also allow for a quieter operation as opposed to larger, louder single motor vacuums.

Van Features "Sit-N-Lift" Seat

GM has become the first U.S. automaker to offer a factory add-on option that allows disabled passengers to get in and out of minivans with ease.

Dubbed the "Sit-N-Lift," it mounts in the factory location without any additional modifications. An original-style seat simply attaches to a heavy-duty motorized base. A remote control for the seat only works when the minivan is in park and the door is completely open. The seat also stops moving if it encounters any obstacle. When activated, the seat pivots 90 degrees, extends 17 in., and lowers to the ground to make getting out of the van almost effortless. The lift has a capacity of about 300 lbs.

When it comes time to sell the van the Sit-N-Lift can be easily removed. If the vehicle is traded for another GM, the dealership will give a \$1,000 credit for the chair.

Squirrel Jambalaya

2-3 thawed squirrels1 cup cubed ham or sliced sausage2 cups brown or white

seasonings, and meats. Simmer on medium heat for 20 to 30 min. until everything is tender, and water is cooked off. Stir thoroughly during cooking. Serves well with cornbread or greens.

Cornflake Candy

6 cups corn flakes 1 cup peanuts 1 cup coconut 1 cup sugar 1 cup corn syrup 1 cup whipping cream

Foolproof 5-Min. Microwave Fudge

18 oz. milk chocolate chips 1 can sweetened condensed milk 2 tsp vanilla 1 cup chopped nuts or other add-ins such as mini marshmallows Microwave chips and milk for 90 sec. or until chips are melted. Be careful not to scorch the chips. Stir well and stir in vanilla and nuts or add-ins. Pour into greased 8 by 8 pan. Cool until firm and cut into chunks. You can use other chips such as semisweet, mint, etc., although melting time will vary. Double recipe for a 9 by 13 pan.
