

## New Way To Brush Teeth



Brush tip rotates at 3,200 rpm's to clean, polish teeth.

"They're catching on fast," says a spokesman for ToothPro, one of the first power tooth brushes introduced on the market.

The new concept in home dental care features a power handle and four interchangeable cleaning heads. The battery-operated power handle spins the small brush at the tip of each cleaning head at 3,200 rpm's. Regular toothpaste is used to scrub and polish the teeth. A battery recharger is built into the base unit which holds the power handle and the interchangeable heads for each family member. The cleaning heads are color-coded so each family member can easily identify his or her particular ToothPro brush.

### INHALES CIGARETTE SMOKE

## Smokeless Ashtray Cleans The Air

How about this — a Smokeless Ashtray that inhales and filters smoke from a burning cigarette.

The Smoke-Trapper Smokeless Ashtray is an 8-in. cylinder of metal and plastic, topped by a battery-powered fan. The cylinder is placed over a 3-in. ashtray and the fan sucks up smoke from a cigarette and expels it through a replaceable filter made of fiberglass and activated charcoal.

The new ashtray is designed to reduce odor and room smoke from a lighted cigarette (one that is not being puffed). It doesn't clear the air of smoke exhaled by the smokers themselves.


"Most of a cigarette goes up in unpuffed smoke. One study showed that out of 570 seconds of smoking, 550 seconds of smoke goes into the air. Only 20 seconds is puffed by the smoker," explain Jeanette Orel, inventor-manufacturer. "The smoke that goes into the air is called sidestream smoke. The Smoke-Trapper Smokeless Ashtray substantially reduces tar and nicotine present in this sidestream smoke."

Suggested retail of the ashtray is \$19.95. Replacement filters cost \$1.50.

## Boil Yourself A Square Egg

New from Harper-Lee International is a sure-fire conversation piece for the breakfast table — a Cubit device that makes square eggs.

You simply boil an egg in the regular manner, then shell it. While it's still warm, you place it in the plastic cuber and screw down the lid. This compresses the egg into a square or cube shape. You then put the Cubit, with the squeezed-down egg inside, into ice water or the freezer for about 10 minutes. The chilling process causes the egg to retain its square shape once the cubing device is removed. Once set by chilling, the egg will retain its square shape at room temperature for a day or more. If you have lots of company coming for

breakfast, be sure to allow plenty of time since, with chilling, it takes about 10 min. per egg for processing after the egg is hard boiled.

Square-shaped eggs not only are a good conversation piece, but they don't roll off the plate. And, their square shape makes them nice for slicing, the manufacturer notes. The cubing device can also be used as a square mold to cube deviled eggs, meat balls and other foodstuffs.

## Handy New Jar Opener

Jars and bottles that won't open are a hassle. Add a touch of arthritis or other complications and they're a downright pain.

Now, to finally unhassle the hassle, comes Un-Skru, an undercabinet, out-of-sight lifetime jar opener that opens every size screw lid from 1/2 to 5 in. — from toothpaste tube to gallon jar — with no adjustments. Simply slip the jar or bottle under the Un-Skru till it wedges, then turn the jar.

Un-Skru attaches permanently to the underside of any table, counter, cabinet, shelf or bar. It's out of the way, out of sight, yet always ready when needed.
