

DNC Fixes All Hydrostatic Pumps And Drive Motors

From the smallest hydraulic cylinders to giant 25,000-lb. behemoths, DNC Hydraulics technicians will take on any repair job.

The Rawson, Ohio, company started out doing hydraulic repair for local farmers and garbage haulers in 1991.

DNC does cylinder repair with a 1-year warranty on completely rebuilt cylinders. The addition of a hydraulic pump repair shop added hydrostatic pump, motor and valve repair.

The machine shop does all types of cylinder repair, recently shipping a 15,000-lb. cylinder to a customer in Louisiana.

"We saw guys paying top dollar for things that we can do for half the cost, and we provide a warranty when rebuilding," says Conway.

"If you have a problem, give us a call," says Conway. "All we need to know is the reason for failure, whether leaking, heating up, or simply weak. Having the model and serial number is helpful, too."

Conway notes that it can also help if the customer sends photos via email or text. "Our average turnaround is 1 to 2 weeks, but hose assemblies are usually the next day, if not the same day," he says.

Glass-Mounted Gun Rack For Tractors, Combines

"Our new glass-mounted gun rack lets you carry any caliber of rifle or shotgun with you on your tractor or combine. It attaches to any glass area to hold the gun rock-solid," says Joe Mullinax, Gun Grabber Products, Inc., Texarkana, Ark.

The patented Gun Grabber 310VT Glass Mount has double suction cups that grip the glass. You set the gun's stock into a floor-mounted rubber "butt" and then press the gun barrel into a U-shaped rubber pocket on the glass-mounted holder. To remove the gun, twist down the front side of the Gun Grabber and pull the gun straight out toward you.

"It's easy to set up, simple to use, and can be easily moved to another tractor or combine," says Mullinax. "It's ideal for modern tractors and combines, which have so much glass there's nothing solid on which to mount a traditional gun rack."

"Once you insert the gun in the Gun Grabber, it won't come out. We have an 8-year contract with the federal government to supply the Gun Grabber to the U.S. Coast Guard, so we know it'll hold up to rough conditions. Also, it's made in the U.S."

The company also offers several kinds of gun rack mounting brackets for UTV's and golf carts, as well as for hunting blinds.

First-Ever 5-Stage Shop Air Cleaner Fights Odors And Viruses

Air-Vac Systems, long-time manufacturer of shop air vac cleaners in Cedar Falls, Iowa, recently announced a first-of-its-kind 5-stage, dual intake air cleaner.

Robert Hughes, president of Air-Vac Systems, says his company has been building and selling its 2-stage air cleaners to farm shops, welding, machine and diesel shops for 25 years. The 2-stage unit consists of a powerful fan that pulls dirty air through an industrial grade, 4-in. thick pleated pre-filter and then through a 95 percent efficient bag-type filter. "The 2-stage unit works great for removing any liquid or solid particulates from ambient air," he says.

Hughes says their new 5-stage Air-Vac unit will also remove odors, toxic gases, chemical vapors, and VOC's. It will also kill mold, bacteria and viruses, both airborne and on surfaces. Hughes reports the 5-stage is also effective against Covid-19.

The 5-stage air cleaner uses the same pleated and bag-type filter as the 2-stage model. It's followed by a 75 percent charcoal bypass filter and finishes with a large ultraviolet (UV) light encased in a titanium oxide filter. "The combination

produces what's called photo catalytic oxidation or PCO technology," says Hughes. "The process creates hydroxyl radicals and super-oxide ions, which are highly reactive electrons that convert harmful particulates and toxic gases into safer compounds, such as carbon dioxide and water."

"PCO technology is many times more effective than a HEPA filter, without diminishing the air cleaner's cfm's as HEPA filters tend to do. A HEPA filter will remove particles down to .03 of a micron, whereas PCO technology takes out particulates down to .001 of a micron."

Hughes says the wife of one of his customers came into his shop a couple of days after he had installed his PCO units and couldn't believe the difference. "She was used to the smells of gas, oil and stale cigarette smoke and said she was glad that now 'the stink is gone'".
