## **Heavy-Duty Live Traps**

If you want a live trap that'll last for years, Daniel Yoder has a heavy-duty model for you. The fabricator and owner of Country Side Repair in Ontario, Wis., sells traps tough enough to catch and hold big male raccoons and other varmints, according to one of his customers, Butch Hooverson.

"I have three of them," says trapper Butch Hooverson. "They are awesome. Two trap models are I caught over 100 raccoons in one for pest control and never broke a wire."

Yoder started making the traps about releasing. 10 years ago based on a design from a

friend who had died. Over the years he made some upgrades, improving it to the point where he can offer a 5-year warranty.

"I use 5/16-in. rod to weld the frame together and wrap it with 12-gauge chicken wire. I use real hog rings to fasten the chicken wire to the frame," Yoder says, noting that even the strongest raccoon can't break the heavy rings.

The 22-lb. cages are 12 by 12-in. sq. and 36 in. long. Yoder offers two models. One has a solid back (\$110) and another has a back door for baiting or releasing (\$125). He sells them at his shop and a few area businesses, but can also ship and welcomes inquiries from wholesalers.



## **Toilet Vac Sucks Odors Away**

"Once it's installed, you wonder how you ever got along without it," says Daniel Antepenko, inventor and manufacturer of the new "Vac-A-Way" device for toilets that sucks odors directly out of the toilet bowl.

The simple device simply bolts in place between the toilet lid and the bowl using the same bolts that hold the lid. A small dia, hose attaches to both sides of the unit under the toilet bowl to a larger hose going to suction fan. A



suction fan mounts up in the attic or crawl space and is wired to a wall switch in the bath-room. "It fits all toilets with top-mounted tanks and is so small you'll hardly notice it. It's very efficient. You don't have to leave it on for 10 min. after using the bathroom like with an overhead fan," says Antepenko.
