Flexible Vise Clamps To Work Surface

The IQ viseTM, introduced by Work IQ ToolsTM, puts a modern spin of functionality and infinite positioning on a common farm shop tool. The unique design earned the 2024 Rising Star Award presented to the top new product at the National Hardware Show.

"The all-metal IQ Vise has a ball and socket joint that is extremely sturdy with a hardened steel ball," says Brandon Smith, director of business development. "It has all of the functionality of a normal bench vise, and with it placed on the edge (of a bench), you can lean it over to work on items like chainsaws or string trimmers."

It has a patented locking pin for heavy-duty holding strength that accommodates 130 ft.lbs. torque. To adapt to different uses, Work IQ Tools offers five double-sided job-specific jaw covers. For example, the Pipe-FitTM Jaws have a metal jaw on one side for welding and grinding galvanized or black pipe and a rubber-coated side for tubular and copper pipes, which is heat resistant when sweating joints. The woodworking jaws are wider and taller, with a stiff foam side to hold molding and other irregularly shaped objects.

"It's more ergonomic," Smith says of the vise's design, adding that some customers

use grants to purchase the vise because of its safety and ergonomic features, allowing you to move the workpiece to you instead of moving your body to the workpiece. The vise sells for \$280, and the jaw covers are additional

Work IQ Tools also offers IQ ConnectTM (\$109), a hands-free system to hold accessories such as a cellphone to watch or make a how-to video while working on a project, a 5-in. magnifying glass, and a detachable flashlight.

IQ Connect can be plugged into one of four ports on the vise, screwed or clamped onto a bench, or used with a magnetic mount when working on farm equipment or vehicles, for example.

The Minnesota-made product dries crystal clear with a UV filter for added protection and has no yellowing, buildup or powdery residue.

Handy Holder For MIG Gun

Matt Stewart got the idea for a MIG gun holder from a friend a few years ago. When he decided to make his own, he added a holder for MIG gun pliers. Using pieces of scrap he had lying around, it didn't cost him anything, but it quickly proved handy to have.

"I started with a rusty, old, vise grip-style C-clamp," says Stewart. "For parts, I cut 2-in. lengths of 1 by 1-in. angle iron, Schedule 40 1 7/8-in. O.D. steel tubing and 1/8-in. wall 1 by 1-in. square tubing."

The idea was to weld the angle iron to one jaw of the C-clamp for a secure attachment to the welding table. To do that, he needed a flat spot on the angle iron.

"I made a few passes on the center of the angle with a hack saw and then filed them down," he says. "I tightened the clamp jaw on the flat spot and welded it in place."

To use, first adjust the length of the Link Latch band. Next, interlock each hook, pulling back until you feel a click. Firmly push the two clips together, then separate them. The end loop can be looped back through the clip if there's extra band. The link latch hook can be removed, and the end loop can be secured to other objects and tiedown points while the holes in the band can accommodate the hooks. Finally, link the clips to self-enclose or add more Link Latches for a longer chain.

The Link Latch is a product of Mella Home. "It's a women-owned business, and we've innovated silicone solutions to everyday challenges," says Hughes. "Our products stand out not just for their uniqueness but also for their consistent performance, earning the trust of countless customers."

Customer reviews aren't shy about calling the Link Latch genius. They rave about the adjustable sizing, the durability of silicone (especially with UV), and versatility. Others found that the holes stretched, causing the hooks to fall out over time.

The Link Latch retails for \$27.99 per three-pack on Amazon and the Mella Home website. It comes with a 1-year warranty. FARM SHOW readers can receive 25 percent off with the code "link25." A similar Mella Home product, the Lid Latch, secures pot lids for a spill-resistant travel option. It's made from food-grade silicone and retails for \$16.99 per two-pack.
