Tomato Jam

5 lbs. ripe tomatoes, quartered (11 cups)
5 cups brown sugar
1 tablespoon whole cloves
1 tablespoon allspice
1 stick cinnamon
2 1/2 cups vinegar
3 cups seedless raisins

Peel tomatoes and cut into quarters. Add to a saucepan and bring to a simmer. Stir in sugar. Wrap spices in cheesecloth and tie, then add to saucepan. Boil slowly for 2 hrs., add raisins. Boil one more hour. Take out and discard spices. Pour jam into sterilized jars and seal while hot.



Blackberry Cake

3 eggs
1 1/2 cups shortening
2 teaspoons cinnamon
1 teaspoon cloves
1 1/2 cups sugar
3 cups flour
1 teaspoon baking soda
2 teaspoons baking powder
2 cups blackberries, crushed

Preheat oven to 350 F. Combine eggs, shortening, cinnamon, and cloves in a large mixing bowl. Beat until well blended. Add blackberries and remaining ingredients. Pour batter into a greased 13x9x2 in. pan. Bake for 35 min. or until done.

Cucumber Sour Cream Salad

1 tablespoon sugar
1 1/2 teaspoons salt
1 cup dairy sour cream
4 1/2 cups thinly sliced, pared cucumbers
3 tablespoons grated white onion
2 tablespoons white vinegar

Blend together sugar, salt, sour cream, onion and vinegar in a bowl. Add cucumbers and mix well. Cover, chill at least 2 hours.

The person who has fallen doesn't need to move or adjust their position. The Raizer M ensures safety for both people and requires minimal effort from the caregiver.

With a lifting capacity of 330 lbs., the Raizer M is built as a seat lift aid to assist seniors or individuals with limited mobility who have fallen to the ground. The Raizer M uses a lightweight manual crank as a patient lift, eliminating concerns about batteries running out or the need to find an outlet when helping someone get up from the floor.

Designed for caregivers, the Raizer M can eliminate the need to call an ambulance or have someone help lift when a loved one has fallen and can't get up.

Quick assembly and disassembly make it easy to carry and store. Collapsed dimensions are 52 in. by 34.5 in. by 11 in.

Users with Medicare Part B are eligible for reimbursement. Contact the company to request the necessary forms to file your claim.

The carrying case costs \$225. Several users recommended it because it includes instructions and keeps everything organized, so it's ready when needed.
