NEW GRAIN MILL "MICRONIZES" FLOUR

Bake Bread With Home-Ground Grain

The smell and taste of fresh, homebaked bread - made from your own home-grown grain - can be a regular treat in your home with help from a new countertop electric grain mill called the Magic Mill II. With it, you can bake your own whole grain bread for as little as 32° a lb., according to the manufacturer.

The Magic Mill produces nearly a pound of fine-ground flour a minute through a unique process called micronizing. Essentially, the grains are "exploded" into uniform particle sizes. A dial controls the air flow through the machine which in turn regulates flour texture.

Nearly any grain, including wheat, rve, barley, corn and rice can be turned into tasty, nutritious flour for bread or pastry. You can even make your own cracked whole grain cereal.

The Magic Mill II weighs 8 lbs. and is about the size of a large toaster. The milling chamber is self-cleaning and the stainless steel flour pan and impact-resistant plastic hopper require just a wipe with a damp cloth. Retails for \$279.50.





Each individual compartment can be opened separately and the contents emptied into the hand without disturbing the other compartments.

New from Energy/Alert is an automatic door knob alarm that goes off when the knob is touched by an intruder, stopping would-be prowlers before they can enter.

The Energy/Alert alarm is battery powered and hangs on the inside door knob. The instant a hand touches the outside knob, the alarm goes off, sounding for about a minute. It then resets itself and will go off again if the outside knob is touched

The alarm works on standard wooden doors with metal knobs (it won't work on metal doors or on sliding glass doors). It can be used in the home or on wooden doors in fuel storage sheds or other farm buildings. It's also handy and easy to take along on trips to guard the door of your hotel or motel room.

To operate, you simply turn it on and hang it on the inside door knob. The unit then takes about 40 seconds to activate and create its detection field. During this time, you can walk out the door and lock it behind you. Upon returning home, the alarm is activated but the door can be opened quickly, allowing you to reach around in seconds and turn the alarm

off. The alarm's sound level is 80 decibels
